***Formulation of & Implementation of Policy***

Arrangement for Consultation/participation of public or its representatives for formulation & implementation of policies for implementation of different programmes are as follows:

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| 1.      | Identification of projects, Selection of villages under SGRY programme and identification of beneficiaries under IAY | Block Selection Committee consisting of Head of Village Institutions representing each G.S. circle and other village social workers, is constituted for the purpose   |
| 3.      | Promotion /Financial assistance to SHGs under SGSY programme   | SHGs are promoted by local NGOs Grading of SHGs is done with the assistance of NGOs, representatives of NGOs facilitating SHGs are also included in DLSGSYC members which review, sanction and make policy decision on the implementation of this scheme. Facilitators are also invited for Block Level meetings.                                     |
| 4.      | Approval and review/ monitoring of Annual Action Plans for all Central Sector Schemes                                | Governing Body of DRDA composing of MP, MLAs & MDCs of the District, Representatives of two leading NGOs, representatives of weaker sections, one representative of rural women and officers of line departments carry out the review, approve AAP, and monitor the implementation of programmes  |
| 5.      | Identification of projects and selection of beneficiaries under State CD Schemes                                     | Block Development Committee comprising of village heads of each GS circle and representatives of cooperative societies, women's organisation & farmers' organisation and also representatives of Line depts is formed for the purpose.  |
| 4.      | Monitoring of all R.D Schemes  | District Level Monitoring and Vigilance Committee with MP as a Chairman, & all elected representatives as members is constituted to keep vigil at the field and ensure implementation of schemes take place in right earnest. Besides this, BDC & BSC function as monitoring units at the field to oversee implementation of Central & State schemes. |
| 5.      | Conducting of Surveys/ Census and before launching of new projects   | Local village Institutions/ NGOs and filed functionaries are mobilized to carry out the programme. Awareness campaigns are also held at the village level   |

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| 6 | State Sector programmes like SRWP, CRRP, CMSRDF | Formulation of Schemes are done by the MLAs concerned for their respective constituencies and execution is carried out by village development committees |
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
