Manner of Execution of Subsidy Programmes

Name of the Programme/Scheme	Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rozgar Yojana /Urban Self Employ Programme.
Duration of the Scheme	Ongoing
Objective of the Programme	To provide gainful employment to the urban unemployed or under employed poor through encouraging the setting up of self employment ventures or provision of wage employment.
Physical and financial target of the programme for last year	Physical: 400 beneficiaries Cases sponsored: 192 Cases Sanctioned:111
Eligibility	Urban poor residing within the Municipality Educational Qualification: Upto IX Std.
Pre-requisites for the benefit.	SMB sponsored an eligible beneficiary to avail a bank loan with a subsidy of 15% or Rs. 7500 whichever is less.
Procedure for availing the Benefit	Collect application forms from the SMB Received application to be screened and those in order will be forwarded to the bank nearest the applicant's address. Bank will sanction.
Criteria for deciding eligibility	Must be from BPL family. Residing in same area for at least three years continuously. Should not be a defaulter with any bank.
Details of the benefit given	Loan amount: up to Rs. 50,000.00 Subsidy: 15% Margin money: 5%
Procedure for distribution of the Subsidy	Subsidy is directly paid to the bank after the loan is sanctioned.
Where to apply or whom to contact for applying	Forms can be obtained during working hours from the UPA cell of the SMB. Applicants may also contact Community organiser.
Application fee	Application is free of cost
Other Fees	No charge
